Discussion took place over continued outstanding fees , with all individual cases reviewed in an effort to get resolved. Section reps to follow up .

A new timesheet has been devised for coaches with notification to be given to coaches of this new procedure.

Travel mileage was discussed for coaches and will remain as it is.

The possibility of holding a holiday club at Easter will be discussed at the next meeting.

Chaperones for competitions will be discussed for each individual competition.

At present there is approx. £14,000 in the bank. The tumble track has still to be repaired as well as replacement of torn mats.

MA & WA Section Reports:

It was agreed that the club would contribute £50 towards those gymnasts selected for upcoming Celtic Cup with the competition taking place in February in Wales.

5 boys have been selected from the club, 4 for the U'17 team and 1 for the U'13 team.

The girls will find out who is selected after squad sessions at end of Jan.

WA had a very successful recent squad trials with 10 girls now being represented in various age group squads.

GMPD Section Report:

Angela Turner is due to take 3 months leave from Disabilities Section with Emma to take over Head coach responsibilities.

There are squad trials to be held in Ireland in February.

Sports Acro Section Report:

There is a Scottish Competition in Larkhall in February and a British Competition in March.

Sports Acro are going to Bulgaria from the 22nd -26th April. The club has agreed to contribute £200 to each gymnast going and everything to be covered for coaches and judge that are required to go.

Discussion took place about upgrading Susan to High Performance level and Rachel to Level 2 and upgrading John to Assessors level.

Discussion took place about possibly raising coaches pay and will be looked at after the current financial year.
